

Off-licence

Sections 17, 19 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

67/OFF/46/2016

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Avalon Estate Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 68 Queensberry Terrace, Luggate and known as Archangel, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free as a sample for consumption on the premises.

As this licence is endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also entitled to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it to somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Onsite sales - Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 6.00pm

Remote sales - At any time on any day

- d) Alcohol may only be <u>delivered</u> Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- f) Order forms for mail or internet orders must require the buyer and the prospective receiver to declare that they are 18 years of age or over.
- g) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue.
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

Expiry date being 14th December 2017 unless renewed for a further period.
